**Nature and Scope:**

The Volunteer Instructor provides excellence in customer service and support, to the members and participants who register in the adult beginner volleyball program. The Volunteer Instructor will be based at the Downtown YMCA-YWCA facility, and must be able to work unsupervised on Sundays from 5:00 – 7:00PM.

**Responsibilities:**

- Follow the rules and guidelines set out by the YMCA-YWCA of Greater Victoria.
- To create a safe, friendly and welcoming atmosphere.
- Provide participants with information on equipment set up/take down, rules, techniques, safety precautions and game play.

- To maintain and develop relationships with members, participants, staff and other volunteers within the YMCA-YWCA.

**Qualifications:**

- N.C.C.P. qualifications are preferred.
- Experience playing/coaching volleyball is preferred.
- Knowledge and understanding with the rules of volleyball is required.
- A clear Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Sector clearance is required.
- Standard First Aid and CPR-C is required.
