



### Third Party Program Providers

Rental clients may not engage in the following activities on Camp Thunderbird property without supervision/instruction by Thunderbird staff and or Instructors under contract.

- Rock Climbing
- Kayaking
- Canoeing
- Archery
- Orienteering
- High Ropes
- Low Ropes / initiative tasks (experiential adventure-based programming)
- Swimming
- Out-trips (back country camping)
- The Animal Game

Camp Thunderbird staff will not share responsibility for the instruction of programs with others. In order to ensure the safety of all clients and staff, we must be clear about who is leading and instructing these activities. Shared instruction / leadership between two parties that may follow different procedures and standards can increase the risk to all those involved. Feedback from observers and participants is encouraged but this must not undermine the leadership position of the Camp Thunderbird Instructor.

Camp Thunderbird will only enter into contractual agreements (ie. Booking contracts) with a “group representative”. This person has direct contact with the participants and in the case of minors, their parents/guardians. For most schools, this person is a teacher at the school. This person is directly responsible for the well-being of any minors that accompany the group to Camp Thunderbird – they have the written authority from the parent/guardian to:

- Authorize procedures, including admission to hospital and necessary treatment therein, as he/she deems essential for the care and well-being of said minor.
- Transport the minor as needed.
